Message from the Presbyter

Dear Friends in Christ,

Family is precious in the sight of God. Family is the theme of North India Family and youth conference also. Peculiarity of the family is that all age groups are contained in it. Hence it is a mini church. Jesus comes wherever 2 or 3 are gathered in his name. Which unit is better than family for 2 or 3 people? That is why church is called family of families. Hence both church and family must have God as its foundation.

When we take the basic unit even within the church, it is a family. Therefore, care must be given to nurture the family, and then the church will be automatically nurtured. In the societies, where family disintegrates, churches also shall be disintegrated. If you seek reason for failure of churches in Europe, I am sure it will end up in the failure of family. That is why through conferences, seminars, pre marital counseling etc., we are trying to safeguard the system, family, which is the building block of the entire human system.

Without God, it is difficult to maintain unity. One elderly Hindu person once told me, while attending a wedding, that out of the whole Bible, he liked the following verse: What God has joined together, let not man separate. He also added if humans obey that that is all what they need.

What blocks us from fulfilling this commandment now days? Is it lack of trust in God or more love towards money or career than family or ones own selfish nature by which one is not ready to adjust, even a finger tip, sacrificing his/her own interest for the sake of family? Yes, it is a combined force of all these that work against the family. Trust in God helps us to maintain a balance between our love for career/money and the family. God then will help us to care for the family even when the career advancement is sought for. Love for God helps us to abandon some of our vested interest or selfish nature, which in turn will help in uniting the family.

This trust in God must be shown by both husband and wife; otherwise also it is difficult to maintain the unity. Or else one will have to share the extra burden of sacrifice to maintain the unity of the family. Hence each children growing in a family must be nurtured in the truth of the word of God so that their family in turn will be taken care of.

To a certain extent, those who maintain a family unit must be experiencing the love of God. That can be the reason why that Hindu elderly person said that it is the most important and needed word for all humanity. Remember that God is included in that verse.

Today the basic tendency is to get separate when some discomfort happens. But that is not the solution for the marriage. One need to examine their basic nature or character, when some discomfort happens and along with God must find a solution to come out of it.

May God, who instituted the family, bless and help us to maintain the family unity of ours' and of our children now and for ever.
