#### Message from the Presbyter

#### Dear Beloved- in- Christ,

"Greetings to you in the precious name of our Lord Jesus Christ".

"But when the time had fully come, God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under law, to redeem those under law, that we might receive the full rights of sons." Galatians 4:4,5

There are two Greek words for time: one is *chronos*, which denotes linear time, from which we get the word "chronology", the other is *kairos*, which denotes the 'right time' or 'perfect time'. Jesus came in *kairos* time, the time that God had prepared. How God had prepared the perfect time for the birth of Jesus, is given below;

- There was universal peace and stability in the world-the PaxRomana or "Peace of Rome" that began with the reign of Augustus in 27 BC.
- There was a lingua franca, a common universal language, Greek, which made it possible for the gospel to be preached everywhere in the Greeco-Roman world.
- There was a deep spiritual hunger for a faith that could give meaning and hope to life.
- There was a growing and widespread belief in one God, partly because of the Diaspora, the dispersion of Jews who left Palestine following the fall of Jerusalem in 586 BC. Wherever the Jews settled, they witnessed to their faith in a single, supreme, sovereign God.

In the 'fullness of time'- a 100 year period between the beginning of Augustus' reign in 27BC and the start of the Jewish War in AD 66-God entered human history by coming to earth in the person of Jesus of Nazareth.

Jesus' Birth narration gives us some of the insights in our lives also. God had designed the birth of Jesus in a different manner. **The Virgin Birth** paved the way for the unique creation of God. God adopts each one's birth in a different way. **Incarnation**: God is becoming incarnate

or embodied in human flesh(Jn 1:14)-the merger of the divine and the human. The story of the virgin birth-or virginal conception is about the incarnation of God in Jesus, not about the virgin birth of Jesus. The incarnation distinguishes Christianity from Judaism, Islam and other religions that believe, like Christianity, that God is infinite, eternal and transcendent; only Christianity believes that God also became incarnate in a human being, namely Jesus of Nazareth. God selected the parents of Jesus in a different way. The selection of his birthplace is also different. The design and plan of each creation is different from others. What is this difference? The answer is that God wants us to be different in this world, which is his special creation, in order to do his special ministry and special mission. The birth of Jesus was a different one inorder to do the mission of Cross and to reveal the redemptive nature of God. Are we sure about our different tastes, nature, behaviorand creation? Are we aware that these differences, which God has given, have certain purposes in life?

In 1818 on Christmas eve, Joseph Mohr, the young priest of village church in Obendorf in Austria, composed a special song for Christmas night service. It was a song of six stanzas. Franz Gruber, the organist set it to music, and both of them sang it on Joseph Mohr's guitar. The stanzas began with the words- 'StilleNacht, HeiligeNacht (Silent Night, Holy Night). That Song, subsequently, became a much-loved Christmas carol throughout the world. The inspiration for the young priest to compose this song was the sight of a young mother in his village parish who was sitting in front of her hut with her newborn infant, shivering in the cold. As she was poor, she had very little protection from the cold. This sight was so touching that the young priest identified Mary and Jesus in the manger with this poor woman and child. The hope and peace in this world is that Jesus the Immanuel is with us irrespective of caste, creed, colour and class.

God uses many, to spread the good news. The role of Joseph is to accept the title of being father of Jesus. The role of Mary is to receive the Divine Grace and give birth to Jesus the Christ. The role of the angels is to bring the good news of salvation to humans. The role of the star is to bring the wise men to Jesus. The role of the wise men is to see the Christ, the king of Jews and to give him gifts. The role of shepherds is to receive the great joy of gospel and to spread it to others. But what is our role today?

I wish you all a happy Christmas and a Blessed New year.

#### **Annual Genral Body Meeting B.D.C- (CNI)**

Rev. Binju Varughese Kuruvilla, Mr. Thomas George and Mr. Monzy Tharian had attended the meeting. The BDC Councilors recorded the important points and decisions in the BDC and noted below:-

FORTY FOURTH ORDINARY MEETING OF THE BOMBAY DIOCESAN COUNCIL – CNI Venue: HUME HIGH SCHOOL, BYCULLA, MUMBAI – 400008 Date: 20-Nov-2015 and 21-Nov-2015

BDC is celebrating its Centenary year (1915-2015) & the strength of Bombay Diocese is as follows:-

- No of Pastorates & congregations 70
- No of ordained Pastors Full Time: 43.... Honorary: 12

- No of Total Members - Male: 45000 .... Female: 32000

#### Following is a brief of BDC Meeting:-

- 1) It is decided that every Pastorate should contribute 3 lakhs to 3.5 lakhs as the minimum assessment per year, irrespective of their share to BDC.
- 2) BDC bye-laws for registration are principally approved as this was circulated to all churches in 2013 for review. If there is any suggestion the church representatives can visit BDC office for discussion before 30-Nov-2015
- 3) All Churches need to be registered as per the guidelines and template to be provided by BDC. Churches already registered may review the existing constitution, bye-laws and amend it to incorporate the guidelines to be provided by BDC by January 2016.
- 4) Bishop expects the Youth to actively participate in Church activities and participate in Inter Diocesan Meetings .He felt that youth participation is very poor.
- 5) Pastors should issue Marriage / Baptism / Confirmation certificates immediately after solemnizing the ceremony.
- 6) 18 Churches has not contributed to Clergy Retirement Fund. It is mandatory for Churches to pay the amount. The treasurer should ensure it's paid on time.
- 7) Diocesan Missionary Movement / Children Ministry
  - a. Mumbai Diocesan Missionary Movement has released magazine MDMM PADA's VOICE & has various active missions.
  - b. BDC IGM joint venture for the development of Karjat Mission. This is planned to be a boarding school for Children of missionaries, Children of poor clergy and local villagers. There will be Health centre, Chapel and a Retreat centre.
  - c. Mumbai Diocesan Children Ministry has released Special Anniversary Issue.
- 8) Pastors' family get together is arranged on 16th December at Hume School.
- 9) 22-Dec to 3-Jan----- BDC office will be closed on account of X'mas/New year holidays.
- 10) C.N.I. Day and the Centenary Celebration shall be held on 29th of November at 4.00 p.m. at St.Mary's Church Parel & the Chief Guest for the same shall be C.S.I Deputy Moderator Rt.Rev.Thomas K Ommen Bishop.
- 11) Action will be taken against Pastorate who has not conducted AGM. Bishop was also not happy in the absenteeism of Diocesan Council Members in the Council Meeting.
- 12) Our following members are nominated to BDC Committees:-

- a. Thomas George Finance Committee.
- b. Mrs.Sinu Ashok Stewardship Committee
