Message from the Presbyter

Dear Beloved- in- Christ,

"Greetings in the precious name of our Lord Jesus Christ."

"Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you."

Luke 6:38

This passage teaches us that we control the flow (amount) of God's blessing and provision to our need. If we give spoonfuls to the Lord, He will pick up the same spoon we used and use it to spoon out what we ask for. If we have faith to give shovelfuls to the Lord, He will pick up the same shovel and use it to shovel back to us what we need in much more abundant blessing.

God does not measure our giving by the amount we give. He rewards us according to what is being left after we give. Jesus said, the tiny amount given by the widow was greater than by all the others because it was all she had. (Luke 21:1-4). Generous giving is proof of our love, faith and maturity (2 Corr 8:24; 9:6,8,13). A generous believer causes others to give thanks to God. The Macedonian Christians were in great poverty (2 Corr 8:2), yet they gave liberally. They had learned obedience in giving. They had learned that giving brings blessing and breaks the curse of poverty. To refuse to be a faithful steward, by giving, is an act of robbery and rebellion toward God (Mal.3:8-12).

This month we are observing harvest festival on 19th November. As we all know, we are focusing mainly on our parsonage project. We need 16 lakhs more to accomplish our task. It will only happen through our wholehearted support and generosity. Each member of our Church has to try to contribute particularly in cover collection and in auction. Try to invite your well-wishers and friends also to be part of our harvest festival.

Report on National Youth Conference

The first NYC was conducted from 20th to 22nd October, 2017, at Mar Chrysostom Mar Thoma Ashram Camp Centre, Kamshet, Maharashtra. The event was hosted by the Youth Movement of the Union of CNI Malayalam Churches in Mumbai and Pune. 17 youth members from our church participated in NYC. The motto of the conference was 'Take a STAND'. NYC was inaugurated by the Most Rev. Thomas. K. Oommen, the Moderator of CSI and the Rt. Rev. Dr. Prakash D. Patole, the Bishop of CNI Bombay Diocese.

The event started off with flag hoisting by Thirumeni followed by release of the souvenir by Thirumeni handing over the first copy to Rt. Rev. Dr. Prakash. D. Patole. This was followed by the first session by the chief speaker, the Rev. Dr. Jacob Thomas, in which we were divided into groups and encouraged to discuss the questions: 'Why should we take a stand? How should we take a stand? What are the consequences of taking a stand?' After the discussion, the winner for NYC Teaser contest was announced and the teaser presented by the youth of Jubilee Malayalam Church, Sanpada got first prize. Cash prize of Rs.1000/- was rewarded, After this, we were treated to a series of performances by the youths of the different churches present, which included an acapella song, a dance and instrumental music among others.

The second day started with morning devotion, where a representative of the International Justice Mission (IJM) spoke about their activities in India, after which there was a praise and worship session. Then came, the second session by the Rev. Dr.

Jacob Thomas, about his experiences in spreading the word of God along with his advice for us youth. After this, we had two hours of relaxation time, which some of us gone to see the nearby dam and enjoyed the picturesque landscape of Kamshet. We returned for a session of Church History and Liturgical Importance taken by the Rev. Samji. K. Sam. The evening worship session was taken by the representatives of the MKD Youth leaders from Kerala and included a skit by them. We were lucky to get an open forum with Thirumeni, in which we were able to get our questions answered, and he also shared his vision for a United Church in India, and what the youth can do to contribute to this. After dinner, we had a campfire, and the youths of different churches led us in song.

The third day, there was the Holy Communion Service led by Thirumeni and Achens. This was followed by a presentation of the mission fields of Telangana, Parkal, Katrappally, Uttaranchal, Charkhari, Bhilai and the Shalom Missions by Achens and Missionaries. The first NYC was concluded with the prayer and benediction by the Rev. Jacob Thomas. The official flag of NYC was lowered and presented to the NYC 2019 conveners, Hyderabad and Parkkal Team.

The stay at the Ashram was memorable, in all parts due to the staff there, headed by the Rev. K.C. Chacko and Kochamma. The food was homely and we all ate our fill of vadas and pazhamporis. The event was, by all accounts, well coordinated. We all look forward to NYC 2019.
