## Message from the Presbyter

**Dear Friends in Christ,**

Sports are an integral part of human entertainment. People from all walks of life love to watch and play games. Children from the very young age learn games and want to spend more time in playing than engaging in other activities, especially in their childhood days. But nowadays computer/video games have taken priority over outdoor games due to time and space constraints, which is detrimental to a healthy human life.

Games convey some important spiritual lessons. Even Paul had used the imagery of athletics to convey spiritual messages. He had exhorted us to run the spiritual race maintaining all the discipline and vitality of an athlete. Since football waves are reverberating everywhere, let us see what we can learn from a sport event like football.

It is a game which we played in our recent sports day and everyone who played it accepted their incompetency in doing this sporting event. Many of our people have got body, leg and muscle pain after the sports day and football is taken as the major culprit in creating this scenario as it shook the whole body. It shows that a game like football needs to be played on a regular basis to keep the body fit for the game.

Lesson 1: Spiritual life is something we need to care for everyday. Otherwise we may become incompetent in our spiritual journey.

Applicable Bible verse- "I rejoice at your word like one who finds great spoil" (Ps 119:162).

Football has got certain rules, which players need to follow for the smooth functioning of the game. If someone tries to outrun the law, it will disrupt the whole match and create discordance among the players and the teams. It is not a one man's game but several individuals are equally involved in this game. Everyone needs to play harmoniously with their teammates in order to play a football match. If anyone tries to play without taking into consideration other teammates then the opposite team is surely going to get an advantage and one's own team is going to lose.

Lesson 2: As in any system of this world, spiritual world also has got certain rules, which we need to follow. If we are going to underestimate those rules, it is going to hurt everyone around and create a great disturbance.

Applicable Bible verse- "If you keep my commandments, you will abide in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and abide in His love" (John 15:10).

Lesson 3: Individuals need to work out together with the other members of the same family since Church is the body of Christ, which consists of many parts. All these parts need to function together for the betterment of a community life. Otherwise we are going to suffer disruption in our spiritual life. If one individual is going to get along with his own ideas and initiatives without considering other members, then s/he is going to damage the entire system.

Applicable Bible verse- “How very good and pleasant it is when kindred live together in unity” (Psalm 133:1).

Players, who, do regular fouls and major wrongs are sometimes dismissed from the game with a red card and they are excluded from the future matches also.

Lesson 4: Time of grace is very limited that we must do our best to keep the track and achieve the goal.

Applicable Bible verses- “I am the true vine and my Father is the vinegrower. He removes every branch in me that bears no fruit. Every branch that bears fruit he prunes to make it bear more fruit” (John 15:1-2). “Jesus told this parable: A man had a fig tree planted in his vineyard; and he came looking for a fruit on it and found none. So he said to the gardener, ‘see here! For three years I have come looking for fruit on this fig tree, and still I find none. Cut it down! Why should it be wasting the soil?’ He replied, Sir, let it alone for one more year, until I dig around it and put manure on it. If it bears fruit next year, well and good; but if not, you can cut it down’ (Luke 13:6-9).”

The spectators in the stadium are engaged in supporting the players. They are not idly sitting or passing time unnecessarily; instead they are actively participating in the game with their music, sounds and instruments. Their presence is a boon for the players and they are motivated to play more fervently.

Lesson 5: Every Christian in his/her spiritual journey is supposed to do his/her small part in encouraging and helping others and motivating them to go further ahead in their spiritual life. Let our participation in this spiritual journey becomes a blessing to others.

Applicable Bible verses- “Therefore since we are surrounded by so great cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight and the sin that clings so closely, and let us run with perseverance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus the pioneer and perfecter of our faith” (Heb. 12: 1-2).
